Pemerintah Beri Dukungan Pasokan Gas, PGN Teken PJBG dan Kerja Sama Strategis di IPA Convex 2025

Jakarta – Komitmen PT Perusahaan Gas Negara Tbk (PGN) untuk terus menyediakan energi baik gas bumi secara berkelanjutan bagi seluruh pelanggan di dalam negeri mendapat dukungan penuh dari pemerintah, yang terealisasi dengan ditandatanganinya sejumlah Perjanjian Jual Beli Gas (PJBG) dan kerja sama strategis dalam forum Indonesian Petroleum Association Convention & Exhibition (IPA Convex) 2025.

Dalam IPA Convex 2025 (20/5/2025), PGN diwakili oleh Direktur Komersial Ratih Esti Prihatini menandatangani sejumlah PJBG, sebagai upaya menjaga keandalan pasokan untuk pelanggan dengan tetap memperhatikan ketentuan dari Kementerian ESDM. PJBG tersebut sebagai berikut:

1. PJBG untuk jargas dengan PGE dengan volume gas bumi sebesar 0,9 BBTUD.
2. PJBG dengan Pertamina EP Jawa Barat dengan volume gas bumi sebesar 12 – 17 BBTUD (ramp up)
3. PJBG dengan MBGI dengan volume gas bumi sebesar 0,35 BBTUD
4. PJBG dengan PHE Ogan Komering dengan volume gas bumi sebesar 3,99 BBTUD
5. Amandemen PJBG dengan PHE North Sumatera Offshore dengan volume gas bumi sebesar 8,48 BBTUD
6. Amandemen PJBG dengan Pertamina EP Medan dengan volume gas bumi sebesar 4,5 – 11 BBTUD.

Selain PJBG, PGN juga menandatangani Heads of Agreement (HOA) dengan Petronas Bukit Panjang untuk meraih potensi pasokan gas bumi hingga 31 BBTUD. HOA ini menjadi awal kerja sama strategis bagi PGN untuk menggali peluang pasokan gas bumi dari sumber yang baru. Kedua belah pihak tentunya akan tetap memperhatikan ketentuan dari pemerintah terkait alokasi yang dapat dimanfaatkan.

PGN Secures Government-backed Gas Supply Agreements to Strengthen Long-Term Growth

Jakarta – PT Perusahaan Gas Negara Tbk (PGN) reaffirms its commitment to consistently provide clean and sustainable natural gas energy across Indonesia, with strong support from the Government. This commitment was realized through the signing of several Gas Sales Agreements (PJBG) and strategic collaborations during the 2025 Indonesian Petroleum Association Convention & Exhibition (IPA Convex).

At IPA Convex 2025 (May 20, 2025), PGN—represented by Commercial Director Ratih Esti Prihatini—signed several PJBGs aimed at ensuring reliable gas supply for customers while remaining aligned with the directives of the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM). The signed agreements include:

1. PJBG with PGE for household gas networks (jargas) with a volume of 0.9 BBTUD.
2. PJBG with Pertamina EP West Java for a gas volume of 12–17 BBTUD (ramp-up).
3. PJBG with MBGI for a gas volume of 0.35 BBTUD.
4. PJBG with PHE Ogan Komering for a gas volume of 3.99 BBTUD.
5. PJBG Amendment with PHE North Sumatera Offshore for a gas volume of 8.48 BBTUD.
6. PJBG Amendment with Pertamina EP Medan for a gas volume of 4.5–11 BBTUD.

In addition to the PJBGs, PGN also signed a Heads of Agreement (HOA) with Petronas Bukit Panjang to explore a potential gas supply of up to 31 BBTUD. This HOA marks the beginning of a strategic partnership for PGN in securing alternative gas sources. Both parties will remain fully compliant with government policies regarding allocation and utilization.

“These Gas Sales Agreements and strategic partnerships are highly significant for PGN to ensure the long-term utilization of domestic natural gas. PGN is committed to playing a vital role in meeting the nation’s energy needs while aligning with the Government’s initiatives to support national economic growth,” stated Ratih.
